TONIGHT'S LESSON:

THE CLEANSING

MARK 11:15-17

15 And they come to Jerusalem: and Jesus went into the temple, and began to cast out them that sold and bought in the temple, and overthrew the tables of the moneychangers, and the seats of them that sold doves; 16 And would not suffer that any man should carry any vessel through the temple. 17 And he taught, saying unto them, Is it not written, My house shall be called of all nations the house of prayer? but ye have

made it a den of thieves.

The Temple was designed to be a "house of prayer" (Isaiah 56:7).

The heathens had turned it into a place where merchants gathered to sell goods and sacrificial animals.

The merchants took advantage of the season, because whenever the time of the feasts came, the prices of the doves, and lambs would increase.

These people engaged in price gouging even in the days of Christ.

The worst part about it was that the priests and pharisees were in on it. The poor who would travel many miles, and sometimes for many days just to get to Jerusalem for the feast, they would often bring their own lambs, and doves to sacrifice in the temple, but the priests had the power to reject the animal for a blemish or spot, and if they did, the poor would be forced to buy an overpriced animal to sacrifice.

Because they were from other areas, their money had to be changed in order to buy the animals, and the money changers would add ridiculous interest, to change money from foreign to Roman.

Also the people were using the temple as a short cut to go thru, people who had no intention of prayer or worship were cutting through the temple to save steps.

Therefore disgracing the temple's sanctity.

This angered Jesus and in the last week of his earthly life he made it clear by "cleansing the temple." He came in and turned over the money tables, and kicked out the vendors. This of course angered the priests and pharisees, and they plotted to kill him.

Prior to his temple cleansing, they were mad at him, but once he messed with their money, the decided to kill him.

I believe there is a historical pattern that goes all the way back to this Bible lesson, you can teach people love, honor and respect, and no one will be upset.

But if you teach them fiscal responsibility, and financial power, the impacted people will kill you.

4And Jesus answered and said to them: "Take heed that no one deceives you. 5For many will come in My name, saying, 'I am the Christ,' and will deceive many. 6And you will hear of wars and rumors of wars. See that you are not troubled; for all these things must come to pass, but the end is not yet. 7For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom. And there will be famines, pestilences, and earthquakes in various places. 8All these are the beginning of sorrows. 9"Then they will deliver you up to tribulation and kill you, and you will be hated by all nations for My name's sake. 10And then many will be offended, will betray one another, and will hate one another. 11Then many false prophets will rise up and deceive many. 12And because lawlessness will abound, the love of many will grow cold. 13But he who endures to the end shall be saved. 14And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in all the world as a witness to all the nations, and then the end will come. (Matthew 24)

- They didn't believe him because they were doing so well, they were so prosperous, and their crops were producing, there was no famine, and they thought their army was unbeatable.
- The reaction to Jeremiah was not that they appreciated him telling them what was about to occur, they hated him because he was telling them what they didn't want to hear. When I see this virus attacking the world, I think of Jeremiah, the weeping prophet, the man God sent to warn the people of the coming doom, and the people punishing him for being the messenger.
- Many of us have tried to tell people that the way the world is behaving will lead to it's destruction. But the world can't hear because finances are prosperous, and there's plenty of food, and luxuries abound, and amid all of that prosperity, God is not pleased. We have come to the point in our history where God has spoken...
 - Your 401k cannot keep you from contracting the Corona Virus.
 - God is not pleased, so what do we do about it?
 - Let's see what the Bible says...


