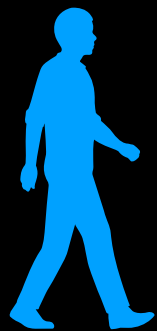

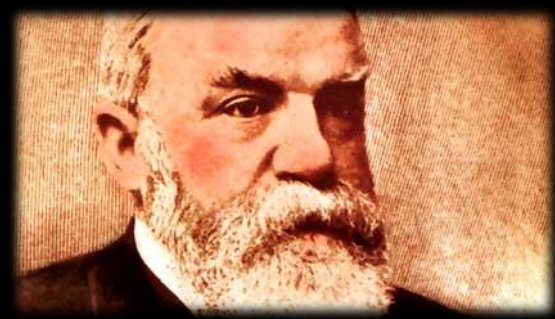

15 I am the true vine, and my Father is the husbandman.

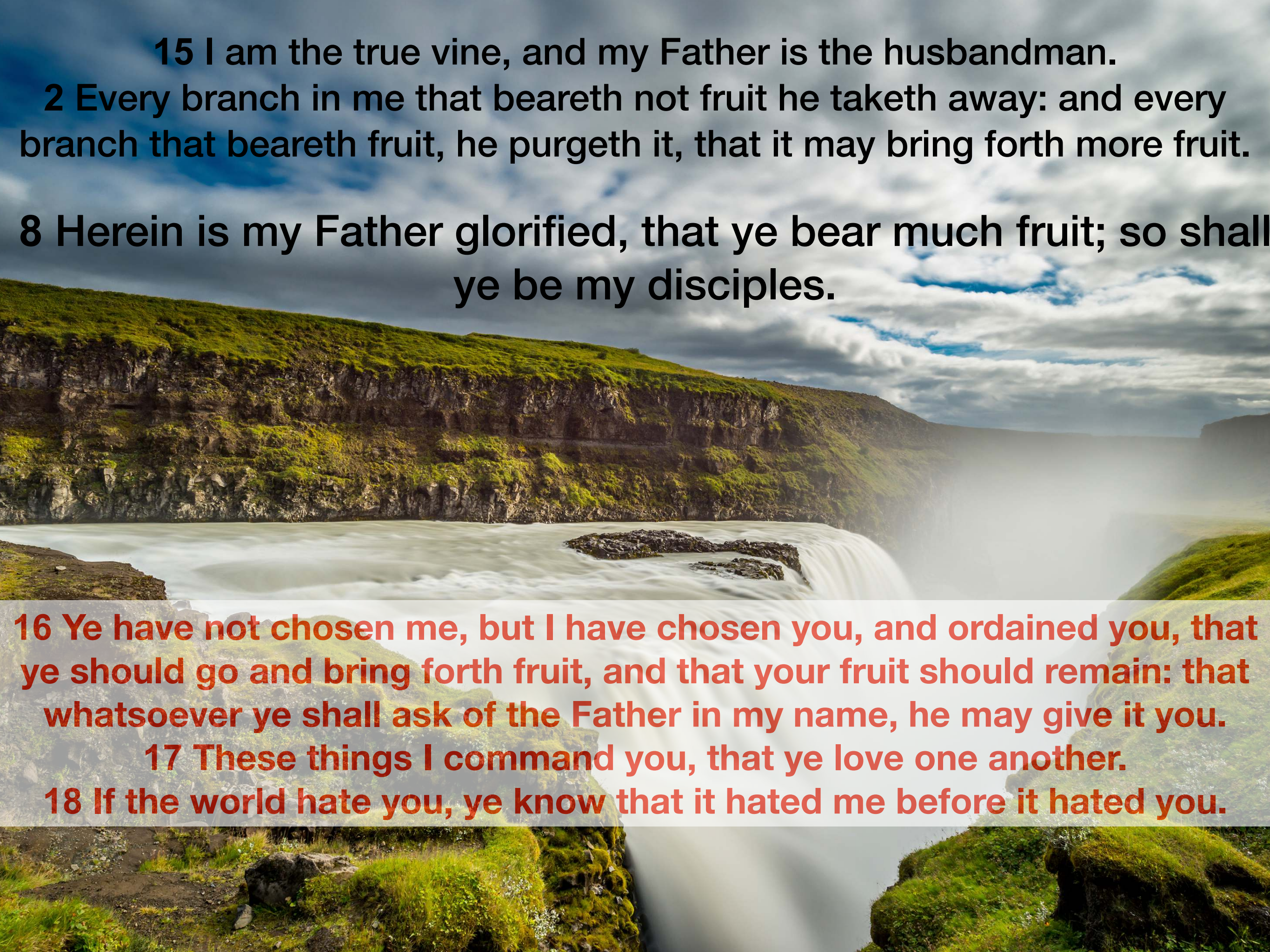
2 Every branch in me that beareth not fruit he taketh away: and every branch that beareth fruit, he purgeth it, that it may bring forth more fruit.

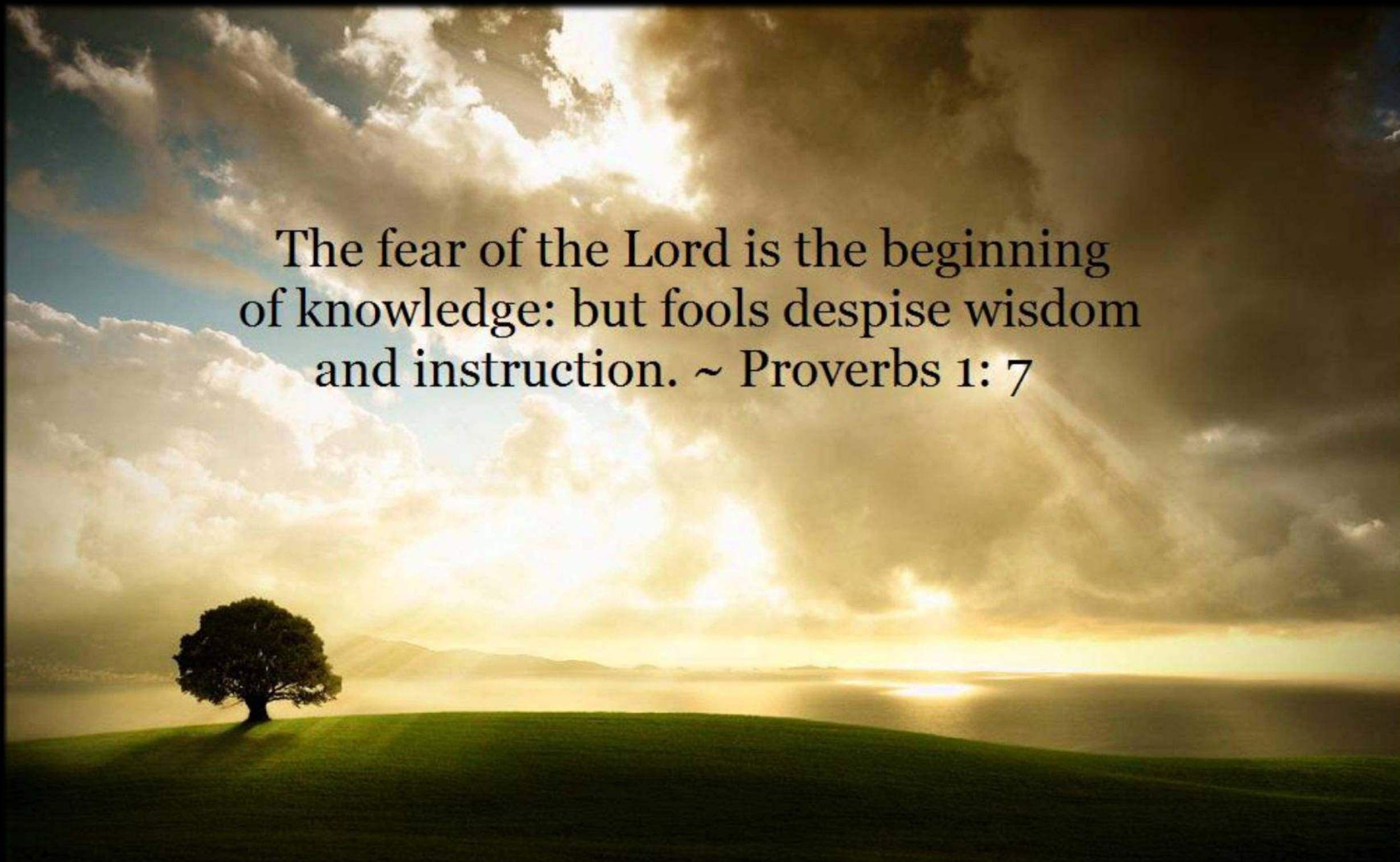
17 These things I command you, that ye love one another.

JOHN'S INSTRUCTION IN WALKING IN THE LIGHT

4 And these things write we unto you, that your joy may be full.

5 This then is the message which we have heard of him, and declare unto you, that **God is light, and in him is no darkness at all.**

6 If we say that we have fellowship with him, **and walk in darkness, we lie, and do not the truth:**

7 **But if we walk in the light,** as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin.

8 If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.

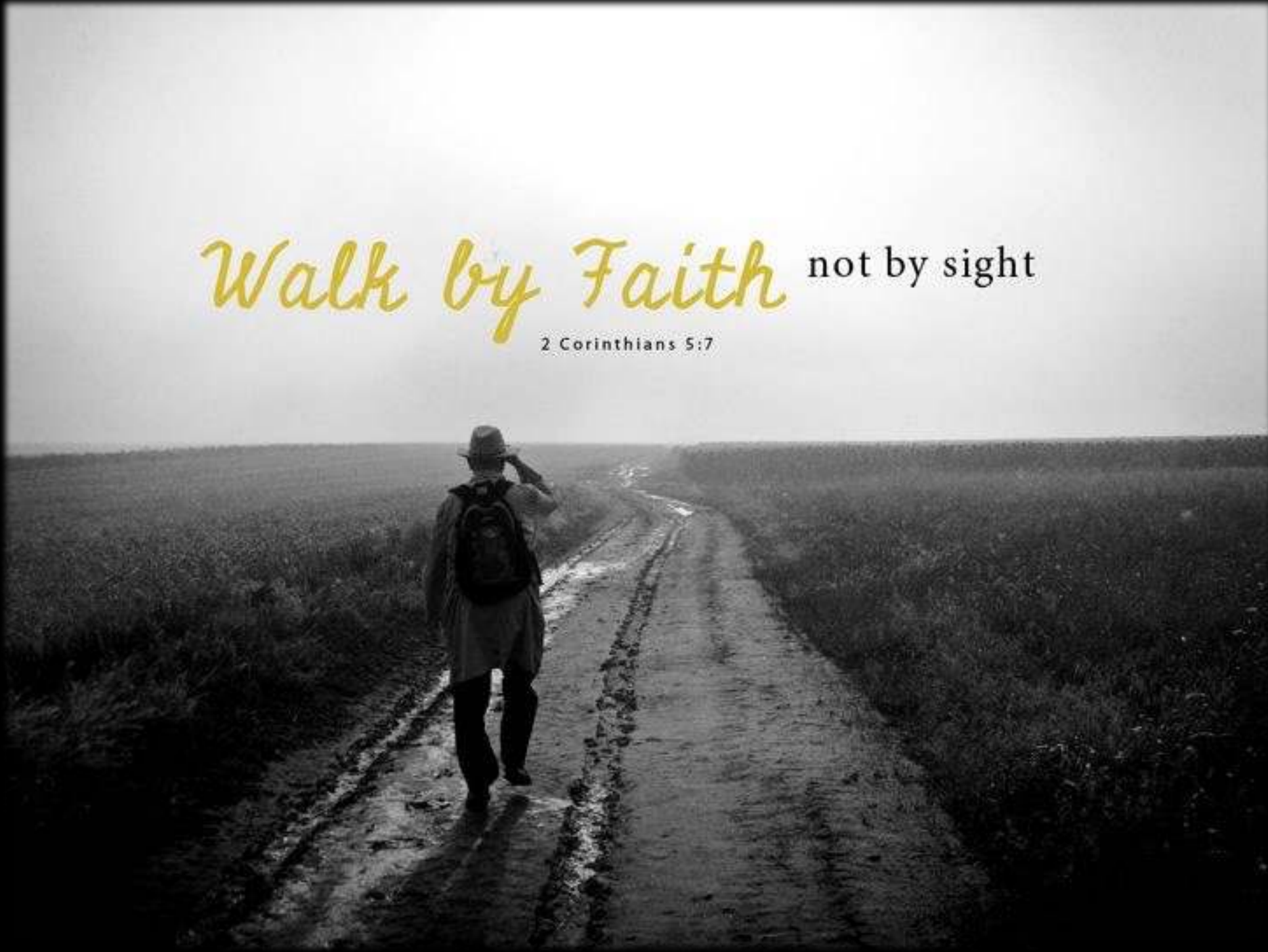
9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.


10 If we say that we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us.
